

Oklahoma Society of Radiologic Technologist, Inc. Student Intern Program

The American Society of Radiologic Technologists has encouraged student involvement through a Student Intern Program. The Oklahoma Society of Radiologic Technologists (OSRT) is equally as committed to student involvement so they have created a similar Student Intern program. The OSRT Board of Directors strongly believes that students are the leaders of the future and the OSRT has a responsibility to cultivate them now.

The major difference between the ASRT and OSRT Student Intern programs is that ASRT student interns only serve during the ASRT Annual Conference. Students selected for the OSRT Student Intern Program will serve for one year – from August to August. The prolonged service period for OSRT student interns should facilitate strong relationships, a fundamental understanding of organizational operations, enhanced leadership skills, and hopefully a commitment to continued service to the profession.

OSRT student interns will be assigned to shadow an officer, a committee chairperson, or a contracted staff member. Shadow experience is designed to offer opportunities to gain organizational and professional insights and provides a mechanism for valuable input on health policy issues, educational issues, and organizational operations that effect all medical imaging and radiation therapy students and professionals in Oklahoma.

Student Representative to the Board of Directors

Duties and Responsibilities

- Liaison for all medical imaging and radiation therapy students for the OSRT.
- Attendance at all Board meetings and business sessions (attendance for Board meetings can be in person or via computer/phone).
- Design OSRT flyers and apparel as requested from the Board.
- Attend the Annual Seminar and assist with registration, student competitions, introduction of speakers, fundraisers, or anything else deemed appropriate from the Board.
- Encourage membership and participation in OSRT events and other professional organizations.
- Keep informed of educational and legislative issues on both the state and national level.
- Act as a role model for other students.
