

Oklahoma Society of Radiologic Technologists, Inc. Scholarship Procedures

PURPOSE

The OSRT wants to assist the medical imaging and radiation therapy students who are in need of financial assistance and may be unable to acquire adequate support from other means.

AWARDS

The OSRT Scholarship Committee will determine the award amounts and eligibility for the OSRT Scholarship. Selections will be made on the basis of financial need, and the applicants must also have satisfactory academic standing in their respective programs. One second-year applicant will be selected to receive the Sr. Beatrice Merrigan Memorial Scholarship. Scholarship awards will be announced at the designated time during the Annual Seminar.

ELIGIBILITY

Students who have completed at least one semester of an accredited Oklahoma Medical Imaging or Radiation Therapy Program are eligible to apply. Students must be a member of OSRT when their application is submitted. Participants cannot be certified in any other discipline. Only second-year students are eligible for the Sr. Beatrice Merrigan Memorial Scholarship (these applicants must also submit a copy of the most current transcript).

PROCEDURE

Scholarship applications are posted on the OSRT webpage (www.osrt.net) under the forms tab. Applicants must complete the application form and a “statement of need” paragraph and send as an electronic attachment to the OSRT Scholarship Email at osrtscholarship@gmail.com. Deadline for submission of this email documentation is February 15. An OSRT Scholarship Committee member will send you an email confirming the receipt of your document(s). The Scholarship Committee may also contact your school’s Program Director to validate your standing in the program.

An application will be considered complete when the following items are received:

- Complete application (*incomplete applications will not be considered*)
- “Statement of need” paragraph written by the applicant
- Second-year students must submit a current transcript to be considered for the Sr. Beatrice Merrigan Memorial Scholarship
